It speaks of his saving love, keeping love, forgiving love and embracing love. Henceforth, it becomes more and more clearer that the Book of Song of Solomon calls each and every member of the Body of Christ to become a Shulamite Bride. It is our Bridegroom's passion to transform us unto maturity, into the holy of holies - His dwelling place; from where HE declares:

"Now you are ready, my bride. Come with me through the archway of trust. Together we will wage war" (Song of Songs 4:8 TPT).

It is an amazing story - a story of how Yahshua makes his bride beautiful and holy by casting out her fear with perfect love. This sent-from-heaven revelation is waiting to be received with all its intensity and power to unlock the deepest places of our hearts.
